Key: 1 amendment:

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof, or abridging the freedom of speech, or the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, petition the Government for a redress of grievances.

2 amendments: A well-regulated Militia, being necessary to the security of a free State, the right of the people to keep and bear Arms, shall not be infringed.

3 amendments: No soldier shall, in time of peace, be quartered in any house, without the consent of the Owner nor in time of war, but in manner to be prescribed by law.
